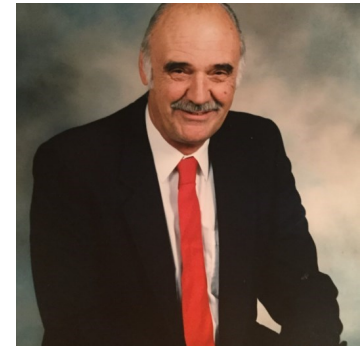

Conflict Prevention:

- Don't Feed Coyotes
- Secure your garbage in a protected container
- Clean up all fallen fruit and spilled bird seed
- Keep pet food inside
- Keep your dog on-leash in areas frequented by coyotes
- Don't leave a small dog out in the yard unattended for long periods of time
- Don't leave cats out roaming

What to do if you encounter a Coyote

- clap hands loudly
- Make yourself appear larger by waving hands swinging objects
- Throw rocks to scare it away
- Carry a whistle and/ or dog spray
- Shout in a deep voice and maintain eye contact
- DO NOT turn away

Honouring Jim Acton

Saturday June 9, 2018 Acton family members and friends joined Kensington community residents, in their community park, to dedicate a bench in Jim's memory. Special guests were Bill and Delores Oppers, Jim and Melanie Gendron, Mary Shalapay, long time Treasurer of Edmonton Area Council One, from the Castle Downs Recreation Society Lynnette Thompson and Neil Chymko and our MP Kerry Diotte.

A number of people had sent their regrets for not being able to join the dedication including our MLA for Edmonton Calder David Egen, Mayor Don Iveson, our Ward 2 Councillor Bev Esslinger, Area Council 2 President Bill Maxim, Area Council 17 President Gord Harris and Kensington Community President Krystal Belitsky.

Showers ended, the sun came out and a beautiful rainbow graced the dedication.

May 8, 2018 we lost the long

time serving vice president of Area Council One Norm Brenneis. Moments of silence were observed in the memory of Norm.

From the community park the group travelled to the Grand Trunk Fitness and Leisure Centre where a new fitness room had been named the Jim Acton Fitness Centre.

It was fitting that we gathered at the Grand Trunk Fitness and Leisure Centre. It was through Jim Acton's leadership of Area Council lobbied first for the construction of Grand Trunk Arena. The north wall of the lobby was once the exterior of the Arena.

In 1976 there was a big party to celebrate the planning and financing that saw the pool built. It was the first time in the history of Edmonton a volunteer group had been involved in the planning, development and operation of a facility such as the Grand Trunk Fitness and Leisure Centre.

Jim was very proud of this and the centre stands as a legacy to him.

We were also joined by City Manager Linda Cochrane and Teresa Miller-Grayston, Director of Edmonton's Leisure Centres.
